

RESOLUTION 1424-22

STATE OF OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NYSSA, MALHEUR COUNTY, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT THROUGH OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT BOARD FOR FY 2022-23.

WHEREAS, the city desires to help keep up with the cost of inflation each year, and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) provides Local Government Grants for up to \$750,000 for Oregon cities to utilize when improving city park facilities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa is an incorporated city of the State of Oregon and has the required 20% matching funds in hand, and

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa has completed a Master Planning Document for the City's parks, and

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa needs to improve the City's existing parks to the benefit of the residents of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Nyssa, Oregon, in regular or special session assembled, do hereby find, declare, and resolve as follows:

1. That the aforementioned Parks Master Plan is representative of the present conditions.
2. That improvements to the City's parks are necessary to the well-being of the City's residents.
4. That the OPRD is respectfully requested to consider the completed funding application for partial funding of the proposed City Park Improvements.
5. That the City of Nyssa does hereby offer to the OPRD and does hereby pledge complete cooperation and assistance to the end, that said City may share and participate in the use and benefit of said Local Government Grant and appropriation; and therefore, does designate Jim Maret as the official representative of the City in all negotiations resulting from this request.
