

## RESOLUTION 1425-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NYSSA, MALHEUR COUNTY, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT IN SUPPORT OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH OREGON BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT INFRASTRUCTURE FOR FY 2022.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Nyssa, the City of Ontario (joint applicant) and the City of Vale (joint applicant) have been collaborating together for the Oregon Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program through the Oregon business development department, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Nyssa as a partner with Malheur County has been working with Community in Action as the non-profit organization for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funding is specifically to be used for a regional housing rehabilitation program that enables low and moderate-income homeowners to fund repairs and upgrades to their homes using local construction contractors, and

**WHEREAS**, the objective of these funds is for decent affordable housing that meets individual family needs, and.

**WHEREAS** The desired outcome of using these funds is a project that promotes livability by improving neighborhoods, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Common Council of the City of Nyssa, Oregon, as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Nyssa is hereby authorized to sign the CDBG intergovernmental agreement in support of the CDBG for 2022 for Housing Rehabilitation.
