

RESOLUTION NO. 1449-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NYSSA, MALHEUR COUNTY, OREGON, DECLARING MISC LIBRARY EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND INDICATING INTENT AND METHOD FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SUCH PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa has Misc. Library equipment that cannot be used by the city and.

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa has no use for the equipment and has determined that no public purpose would be furthered by retaining ownership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Nyssa, Oregon, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Nyssa declares the library equipment as surplus property and the City Manager of the City of Nyssa is hereby authorized to arrange the sale of the following by auction, donate to a charity organization or discard

1. Metal Frame coat rack-72” long, 55” tall
2. Plastic chairs-5 orange, 6 mustard-colored, 14-inch-high child-size chairs with metal legs
3. Book rack wood sides with wire racks-44” wide, 60” tall
4. Small white rack for holding plastic bins minus the bins, 31” tall, 33” wide, 11” deep
